



Heritage Hall 100 Stay Connected Contest

The rules and regulations below govern the Board of Governors of the Southern Alberta Institute of Technology's (SAIT) Heritage Hall 100 Stay Connected contest ("Contest").

Rules are binding

Subject to applicable laws, these rules and regulations (the "Rules") govern all aspects of the Contest and are binding upon all entrants. In the event of any inconsistency between the Rules and the conditions and explanations appearing in any other documents, the Rules shall take precedence. This Contest is void where prohibited by law and is subject to all federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. This Contest is subject to the laws of the Province of Alberta and the federal laws of Canada applicable herein and any disputes arising pursuant to the Contest will be submitted to Courts located in Calgary, Alberta. SAIT reserves the right to make changes to the Contest and these Rules including the right to substitute the prizes with prizes of equal or greater value where necessary, due to changing business, operational and/or marketing considerations.

Eligibility

The Contest is open only to alumni of SAIT. Each entrant must be legal resident of Canada and at least 18 years of age at the time of entry into the Contest. Residents of Quebec are excluded from participating in the Contest. Any entrant under the age of 18 must have written permission from the entrant's parent or legal guardian and by entering the Contest represents and warrants that such written permission has been granted.

SAIT reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify at any time an entrant who does not meet the Contest's eligibility criteria, fails to comply with these Rules, attempts to enter the Contest in any manner or through any means other than as described in these Rules, or attempts to disrupt the Contest or to circumvent any of these Rules.

Contest period and draw date

The Contest opens at 8:00 am (MST) on Monday, April 4, 2022 and closes at 11:59 pm (MST) on Saturday, April 30, 2022 (the "Contest Period"). A random draw will be held after the Contest Period and the names of the winners will be notified by email on Wednesday, May 4, 2022 by 4:00 pm (MST).



How to enter

There is no fee to enter the Contest; no purchase is necessary. To enter the Contest, eligible entrants must update their contact information using the "Stay Connected" form at <https://sait.imodules.com/s/1615/gid2/18/interior.aspx?sid=1615&gid=2&pgid=2624&cid=6206>.

Entrants can only submit one entry to the Contest.

SAIT reserves the right to disqualify Contest entries that are deemed offensive or inappropriate or for any other reason, at its sole discretion.

No Remuneration

You acknowledge and agree that you are granting all rights set out in these Rules to SAIT on a fully-paid-up and royalty-free basis, that you will receive no further financial or other remuneration, and that SAIT may exercise all of its rights set out in these Rules without providing any further financial or other remuneration to you.

Skill-Testing Requirement

To be eligible to receive a prize, you must answer the following skill testing question: 150 multiplied by 3, divided by 2, minus 6 $[(150 \times 3) / 2 - 6]$.

Prizes

There is one (1) prize to be won: One (1) \$500 VISA gift card.

Odds of Winning

The odds of winning one of the eight prizes depends on the number of entries received during the Contest Period.

Prize Redemption

The winner will be notified by email after the contest draw on May 5, 2022. If a prize winner cannot be contacted after three (3) business days, or the prize winner does not meet the criteria contained in these Rules, another entrant will be randomly selected from the remaining eligible entries.

Prize winners must provide their contact information (mailing address, preferred email address and telephone number) in order to collect their prize. An Alumni Relations Officer will make arrangements with the individual winners to collect their prize. If the winner cannot collect their prize within thirty (30) days or does not meet the criteria contained in these Rules, then the prize shall lapse.



Acceptance of Prize

Prizes must be accepted as awarded and cannot be exchanged for cash or for other goods and services. The award of each prize is random. Winners must provide proof of identification and may be required to provide proof of graduation from SAIT prior to receiving their prize. SAIT may disqualify a winner if SAIT determines, in its sole discretion, that such proof of identification or graduation is insufficient. If the identity of the winner is disputed, another entrant will be randomly selected from the remaining eligible entries.

Prize Affidavit, Eligibility Release Form

A prize winner will be required to complete and sign a Prize Acknowledgement and Release form before receiving his/her prize. If a prize winner is a minor, the minor's parent or legal guardian must also sign the Prize Acknowledgement and Release form.

Publicity and Use of Personal Information

By participating in the Contest, entrants consent to the use of their names, cities of residence, photographs and/or images (the "Personal Information") for publicity purposes in all media carried out by SAIT without payment or compensation or liability for use of same.

The Personal Information is collected under the authority of the Post-Secondary Learning Act (Alberta) and the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (Alberta) ("FOIP"). Your Personal Information is protected by FOIP and can be reviewed on request. Limitation of Liability

By signing the Prize Acknowledgement and Release form, prize winners release SAIT, its governors, officers, employees, agents, consultants and representatives from all liability arising out of, pursuant to, or as a result of the carrying out of the Contest, including liability arising from the participation in the Contest, acceptance and use of the prizes, and compliance with the Rules.

SAIT is not responsible for forwarding prizes to winners who do not pick up their prizes. SAIT is not responsible for any prizes awarded or not awarded as a result of technical, mechanical, computer, telecommunications disruption or other similar errors, however caused.
